Inclusive dance is a long term united creative work for people with disability and non-disabled persons.

Inclusive dance is a complex of characters and features:

- Involving people with different kinds of disorders (hearing, sight, musculoskeletal, mental) in dance art.
- First of all, people with the hardest diseases must be involved in this dance movement. The purpose of inclusive dance is to help in making a better social environment by means of dance.
- Person with disability and nondisabled person must take part in inclusive dance.



Inclusive Dance concept

- Using of different styles of dance and art from ballet, folk, pop and ball dance to modern dance and hip-hop.
- Combining of free movement (improvisation) and established dance styles in inclusive dance.
- Combining features of dance art, rehabilitation work and voluntarism.
- Communication between people by means of different dance movement is much more important than competitive dancing.
- Competition is only one form of interaction of people by means of dance.







Inclusive Dance concept

- Inclusive choreography is a way of expressing the inner emotions of dancing person, the real story of his feelings, thoughts and his life.
- The dancer without disability is a volunteer, assistant in dance and in everyday life. He can be an assistant, dancer, teacher and choreographer at the same time. He must learn to be a follower and help his partner to become a leader.
- Mental and physical development of disabled dancer is more important than choreographer, assistant or dance teacher's self-assertion or ambition.



Inclusive Dance concept

- Inclusive dance is a base for sincere friendship of people with disability, their relatives, volunteers, teachers and choreographers.
- The festival is made up of a synthesis of different dance formats: workshops, jam-sessions, balls, competitions, show programs, dance performances and other events.
- Inclusive dance festivals are held all over the world as events which unite people of different nationalities, cultures, peculiarities, forming greater tolerance and strengthening friendship between nations.







The first level: networks of friends, inclusive dance experts

network of promoters & organizations, heads of the inclusive dance teams, teachers, therapists and other inclusive dance specialists in different countries



Structure of the Association

- Organization promoters (in each country) are already up and running organizations engaged in the management of the different countries
- Inclusive dance groups; non-governmental organizations that support the inclusive dance groups.
